

Nancy retired from the practice of law on January 31, 2022. Named repeatedly as a top benefits lawyer by national and regional publications, Nancy served as Co-Chair of Winston & Strawn's Employee Benefits and Executive Compensation Practice and the Retirement Plans practice group. Nancy advised some of the world's largest employers on their employee benefit plan design, amendment, termination, administration, governance and ERISA fiduciary matters affecting tax-qualified and nonqualified retirement and deferred compensation plans. She often represented clients before the Internal Revenue Service, Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation, and Department of Labor. Nancy received a Lifetime Achievement award from the Plan Sponsor Council of America upon her retirement.

Nancy is on the Board of the Chicago Bar Foundation, currently serving as its Treasurer, and is a member of the CBF's Justice Society.
