The Chicago Bar Foundation's overall approach to ensuring access to justice for all people in the Chicago area centers on creating a comprehensive, coordinated and fully accessible delivery system. There is no "one size fits all" solution to ensure that everyone has access to justice; rather, an integrated range of information and services must be fully available to meet the legal needs of low-income and disadvantaged Chicagoans. The CBF's mission recognizes that Chicago's legal community must take a lead role to develop such a system and that achieving this goal requires strong legal aid organizations, dedicated pro bono and legal aid attorneys with the resources to do their work efficiently and effectively, and a user-friendly and accessible legal system.
